

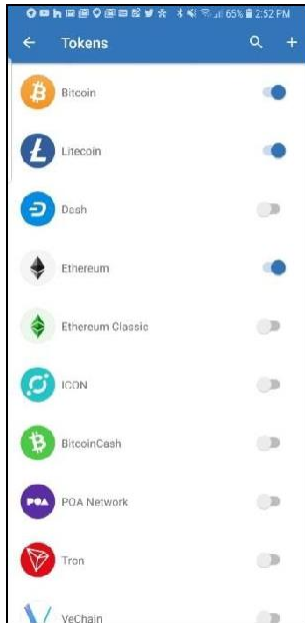
B. Mobile Phone (e.g. Trust)

Trust Wallet is a fast and secure multi cryptocurrency wallet that manages and stores your VeAssets and other digital assets. The wallet connects to the VeADIR using the built-in DAPP access. You can download and install the trust wallet in IOS or Android:

- iOS – Apple App Store
 - Android – Google Play Store
- i. Once installed and opened, Go to the Settings tab, select Wallets then click + in the upper right corner.



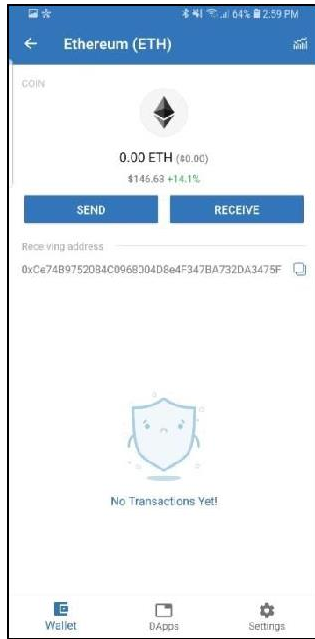
- ii. Create a new wallet (or import an existing wallet). Click the informational “i” and ensure your private key is backed up. Again, write your key and store it away from your mobile device. You can only do get your private key when first creating the account.
- iii. If you have not done so already, Click the “+” sign again to enable the tokens you would like to hold in this wallet. Make sure Ethereum is enabled so you can add ETH and VERI.



- iv. Click the back arrow and you should now see the tokens that are enabled on your mobile device.



- v. You can send ETH to this account address from an exchange or another wallet by clicking on Ethereum to either **send** or **receive**. You should see your receive address below these buttons.

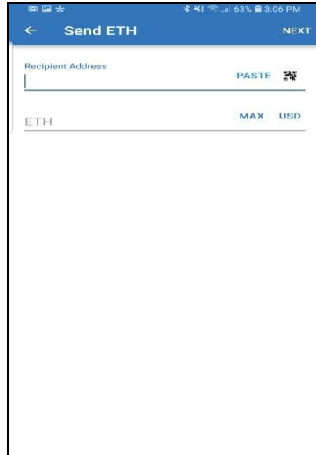


- vi. You can click on the squares to the right of the address to copy it. Or, you can click on the Receive button to use a QR code that can be scanned by the device you're sending from. You can also enter and confirm the number of tokens you want to receive.

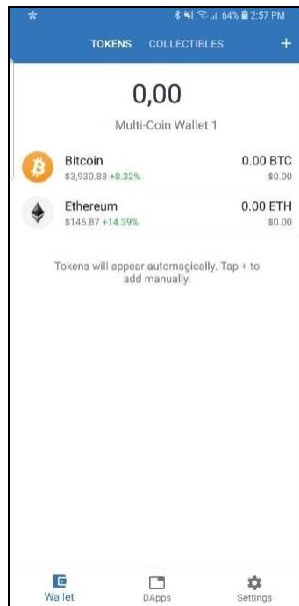


- vii. If you are sending tokens, paste the correct recipient address for the type of network token you are sending in the space provided. Notice the top of the screen indicates that you are sending ETH. You can also copy a QR code by clicking the small QR code icon found at the end of the address space. This opens up your camera so the recipient's address can be scanned.

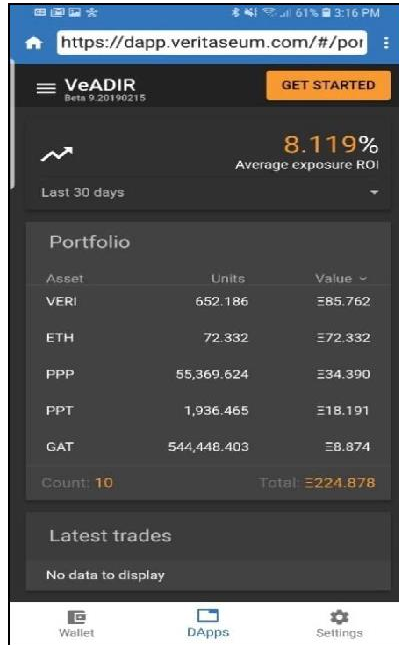
Just hold your camera over the QR code for it to be read. Once it's copied into the space, you can enter the number of ETH you plan to send. It will also show the USD equivalent of the amount you enter.



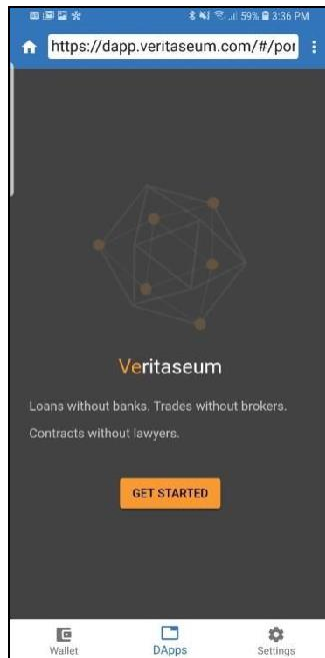
- viii. Go back to the main wallet page that shows the types of tokens you have enabled. On the bottom of the screen click on the DApps button.



- ix. In the search bar on top of the page, enter the Veritaseum DApp address, **DApp.Veritaseum.com** which will open the VeADIR. You will see all the information you would with the Desktop version except the layout is modified for your mobile device.

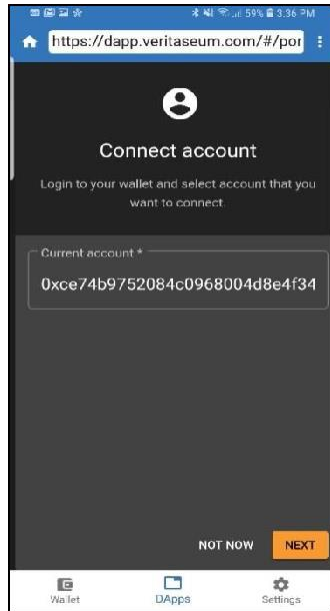


- x. As with the desktop version, you must make a KYC submission. Anyone who uses the VeADIR must successfully complete the KYC process.
- xi. Click on the **Get Started** button and then again, the **Get Started** button that pops up on your screen

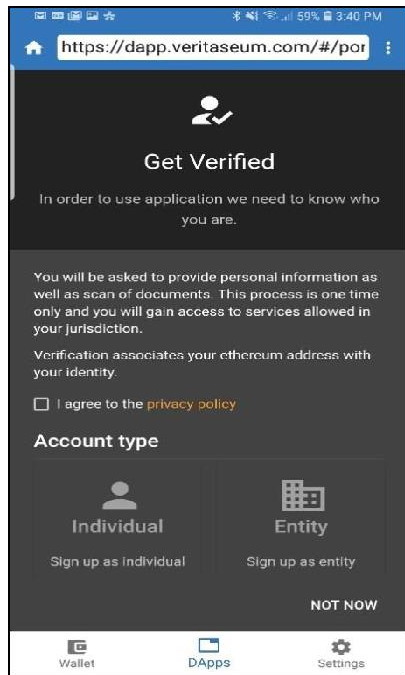


- xii. Because your Trust wallet is open, you will now see your public address listed in the connect account screen. Your wallet address is your unique and main identifier in the VeADIR and it

is tied to your KYC data. If you want to use a different wallet than the one that is currently open, just copy the public address and replace the existing address by pasting it into the account box. For that account's contents to show once you are approved to use the VeADIR, it must be accessible from and open in your mobile device.

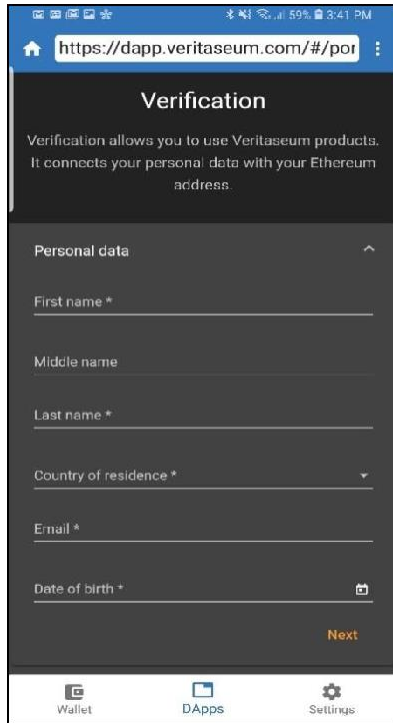


- xiii. Click next after ensuring the right wallet address is in the box
- xiv. You should now see the **Get Verified** box. This is where you start the KYC process. As mentioned earlier, anyone who uses the VeADIR must be properly verified through our KYC process, whether you are an individual or an entity/company. Companies require more information than individuals including corporate documentation and KYC information on all their beneficial owners. Both individuals and entities may be subject to additional information requests if your prior activity or status needs additional review. If you are from an OFAC country or one that is currently under sanction by any , you will not be able to register.



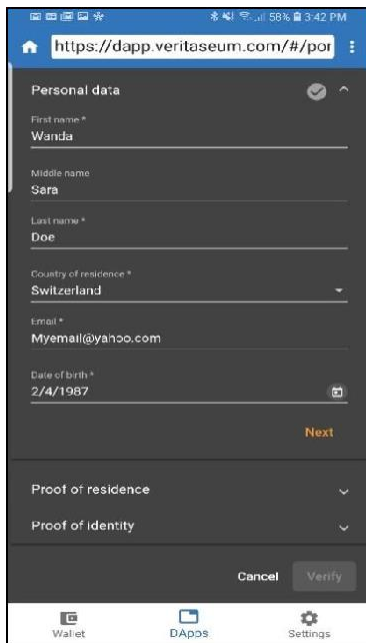
- xv. Review the information provided and the privacy policy (highlighted next to the check box) before checking that you agree to our privacy policy.
- xvi. Then select the appropriate box, either Individual or Entity (if you are registering your company). You also have the option to start again by clicking the **Not Now** button. However, as mentioned before, you won't be able to access any features of the VeADIR until you complete the KYC process and have been approved. We will select Individual for this demonstration.
- xvii. After selecting Individual, you will see the initial verification screen. There are three (3) main sections. All three must be completed.
 - a. Personal Information
 - a. Proof of Residence
 - b. Proof of Identity

There is a small arrow button to the right of each section that will open it for your completion. We will go through each now.

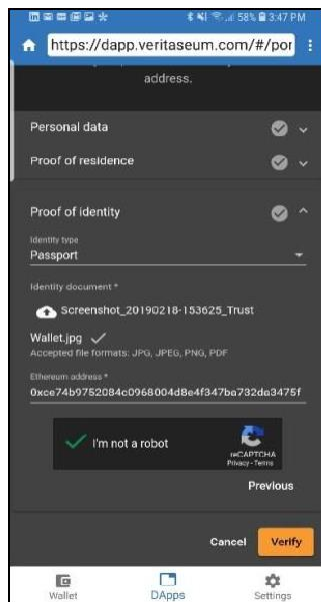

Under **Personal Data**, enter all the information requested. What you enter here **MUST** match your proof of residence and proof of identity documents in order to be approved. When you've completed your entries, you will see a check in the upper right corner of the section and will be able to select **Next** to move to **Proof of Residence**.



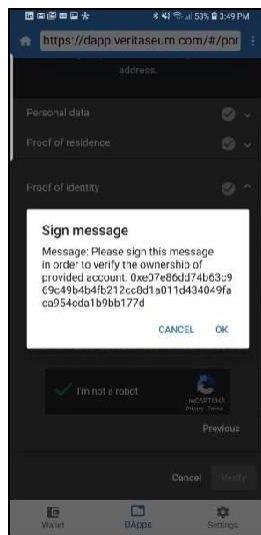
- xix.** Under **Proof of Residence**, you are asked to upload a recent document with your name that proves your address. The type of file you can upload is shown under the upload link. The document must be **no more than three (3) months** old. To help you, the earliest date acceptable is shown under the different allowable file types. Click on the **Upload file** link to browse and attach a file from your device or use your camera to take a photo of it. If you upload documents that are too old, don't contain your name as you entered it in the first section or are not adequate to prove residence (e.g. a mobile phone bill), your KYC submission will be rejected. If rejected, you can retry the KYC process when you have the right documentation.
- xx.** Under Proof of Identity (or any of the three) you may see a red warning. This is because we opened and then closed the tab without entering any information. This will go away as soon as we enter what is required.
- xxi.** You first must select the identity type, whether identity card, driver's license or passport from the pulldown menu. Then click on the Upload file link to submit a clearly legible image of your document from your computer. The acceptable file types are given. Click on the **"I am not a robot"** button, which provides additional security. Your wallet address is displayed again for verification. Please ensure this is the wallet you intend to register under.



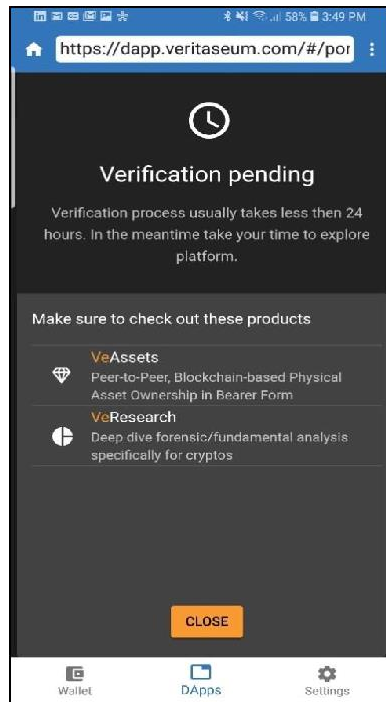
- xxii.** As an update to **Proof of Identity**, you may also be required to upload a 3-7 second video of you holding and moving your ID near your face. Your face must be clearly visible and the document must be fully legible including the watermarks. You can record this selfie on a smartphone or have someone help you. However, the face and ID on the video must match

the ID submitted and the personal data entered to gain approval. After you have uploaded your selfie, click the **Verify** button to submit your KYC information for review. If you do not see this requirement listed, just click the **Verify** button to submit your KYC information for review.

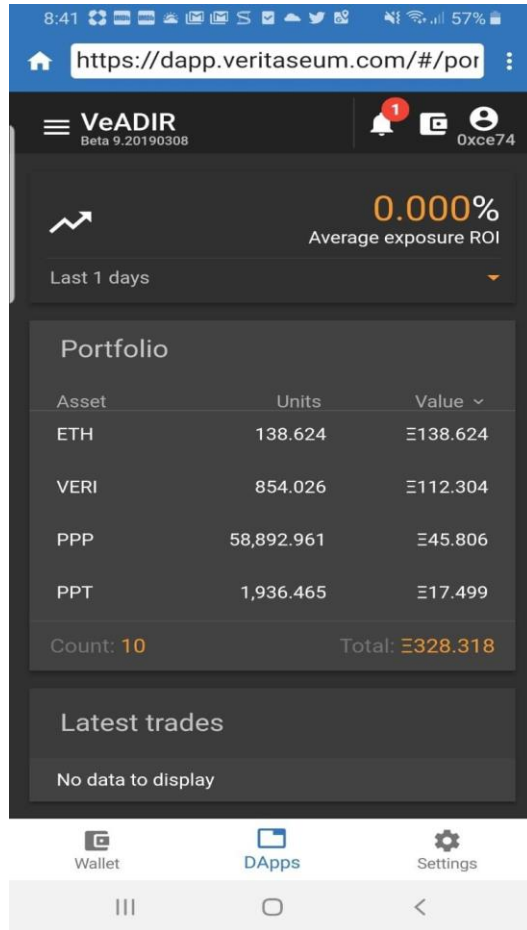
- xxiii. After clicking **Verify**, you will see a popup that will ask you to sign as confirmation of your desire to submit your documents for review and to verify that you own the wallet being submitted. Click sign if you wish to move forward OR cancel if you don't want to move forward with verification at this time.



- xxiv. If you click **cancel**, as at any time during the KYC process, you will see a disclaimer letting you know that without KYC you can only explore and learn about the different aspects of the VeADIR as well as access free research for review. Click **I understand** to continue exploring the VeADIR.
- xxv. Once you click on **Verify**, you will receive a message showing that your verification is pending. It should take 24 to 48 hours for review and approval/rejection. You can click close. In the upper right corner of the app you will now see verification pending. You can click through the various sections of the VeADIR to explore and familiarize yourself until your application is reviewed.



- xxvi.** Check back in 24 to 48 hours, with your submitted wallet open, to ensure your status has been changed to approved. This will be by seeing a person icon with a partial of your public address underneath where **Verification Pending** used to be. If you were rejected, you will see a **Get Started** button, where **Verification Pending** used to be.



- xxvii. Once approved, you will have access to any areas of the VeADIR allowed in your jurisdiction. The other areas will be grayed out.
- xxviii. If at any point in the process you have trouble with the system, please click the help button in the bottom of the menu on the left. There you will find a user guide and helpful videos. You can also [Send Us Feedback](#) if you have a specific issue that the guide or videos do not address.
