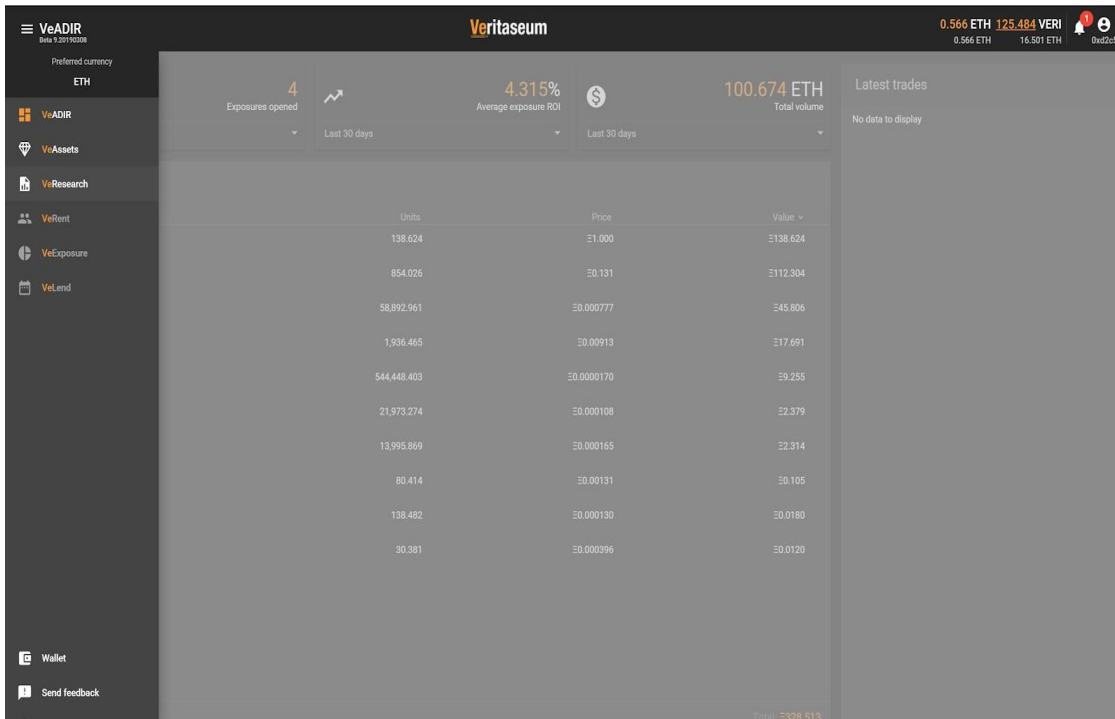


3.1.2. USING THE MENU

The menu is located on the left side of the VeADIR and is represented by several icons. Once you hover over on an icon it will open to describe the sections represented by all the icons. Click on any icon to navigate to that page. The icons remain visible in each section of the VeADIR to make it easier for you to navigate through the platform.

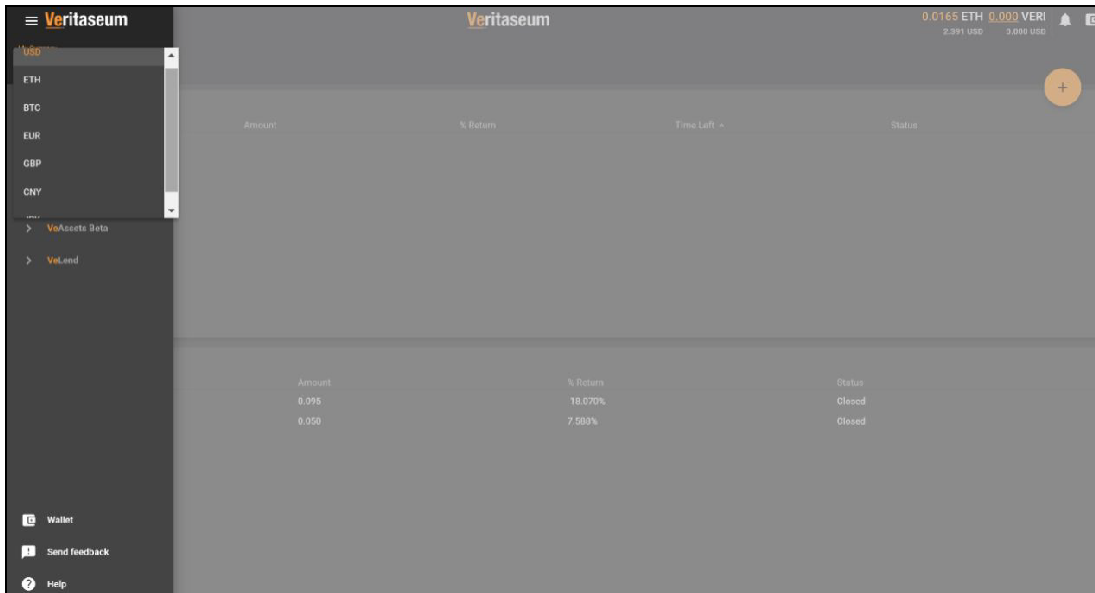


At the top of the menu you will see either a digital or fiat currency abbreviation. Click on the currency to see the currency list. You can see values throughout the VeADIR in any of several currencies. The following currencies are currently supported:

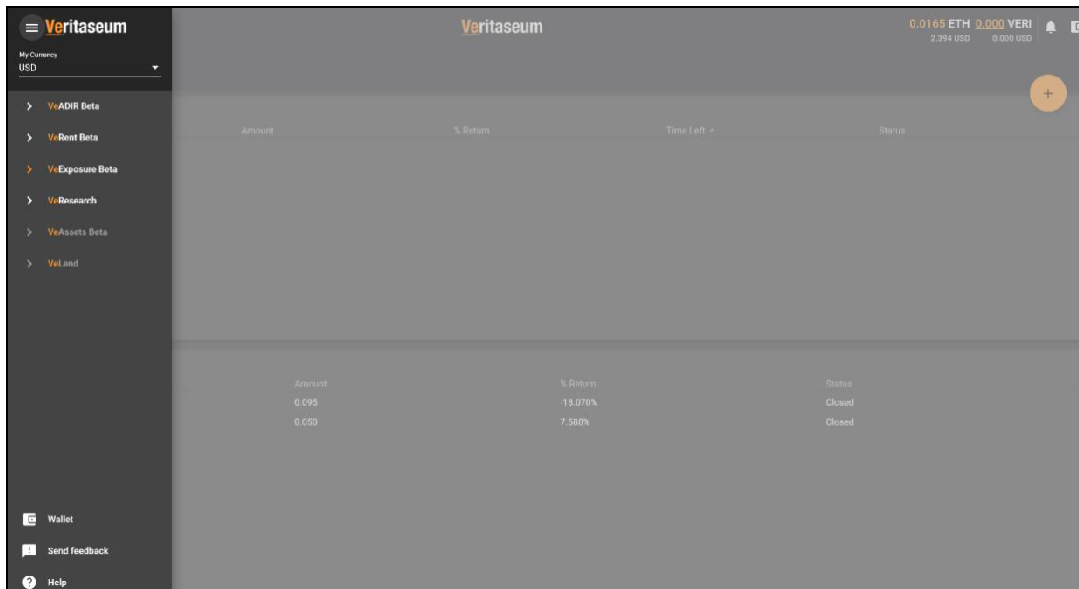
- USD – United States Dollar
- ETH – Ethereum
- BTC – Bitcoin
- EUR – Euro
- GBP – British Pound
- CNY – Chinese Yuan
- JPY – Japanese Yen

We are adding more to the list as our global reach expands. Just click on the preferred currency you would like to view the VeADIR in. and you will be able to see every accessible page in that currency until

you change it to something else.



1. Next, you will see a list of icons representing all of Veritaseum's products and services available in the VeADIR to users. You can navigate to view or use, if approved, any of these items by simply clicking on it. Any product/service you are not approved to use based on your jurisdiction, will be grayed out and moved to the bottom of the list.



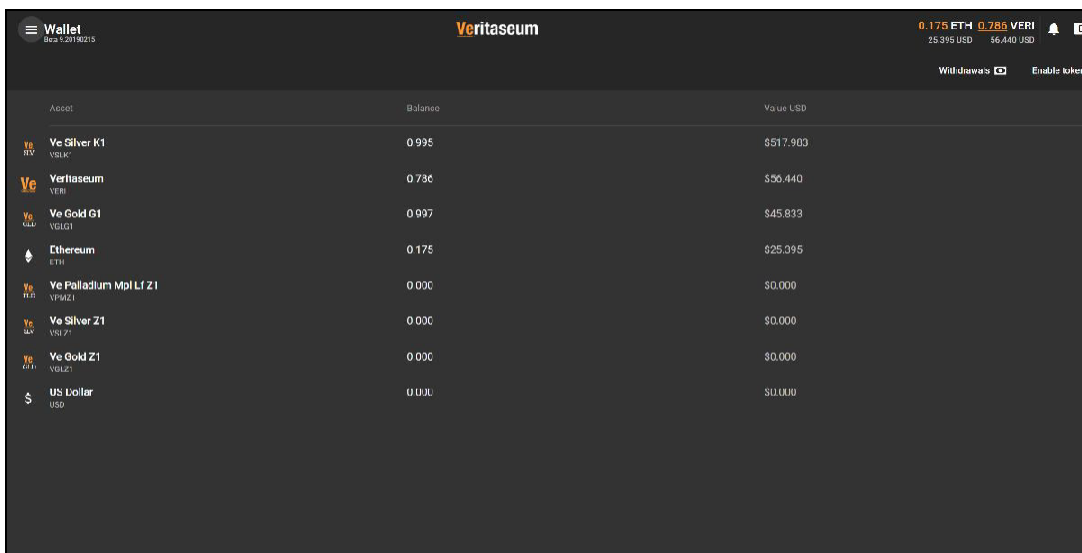
- 2 At the bottom of the list, you can click on **Wallet** to see all the items in your wallet. This feature facilitates the use of your wallet as it allows you to see your current VeADIR-related holdings without having to go back to your Metamask/Trust or other interface when you are ready to transact. It remains visible to only you.



When you click on **Wallet** a list of assets contained in your account will be displayed.

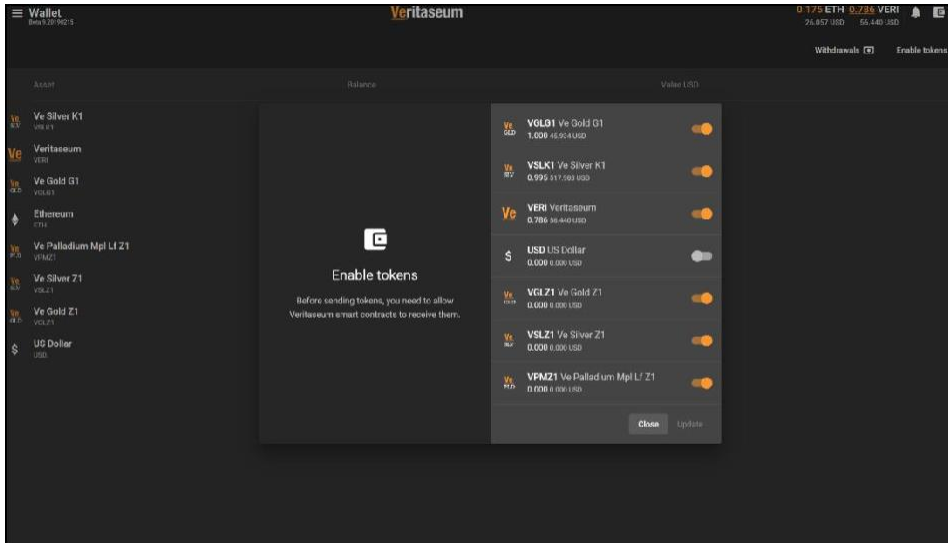
The following lists of assets are currently supported in the wallet with others being added as we expand:

- **VERI – Veritaseum**
- **ETH – Ethereum**
- **VGLZ1 – Ve Gold Z1 (1 oz)**
- **VGLG1 – Ve Gold G1 (1 gram)**
- **VSLK1 – Ve Silver K1 (1 kilo)**
- **VSLZ1 – Ve Silver Z1 (1 oz)**
- **VPMZ1 – Ve Palladium Z1 (1 oz)**

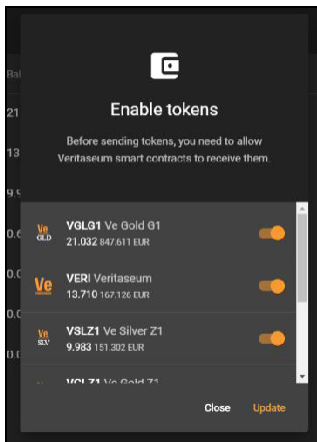


From the wallet you can enable your tokens so they can be sent, received or used in the VeADIR. To enable tokens, click on the Enable tokens slide bar on the top right of the screen.

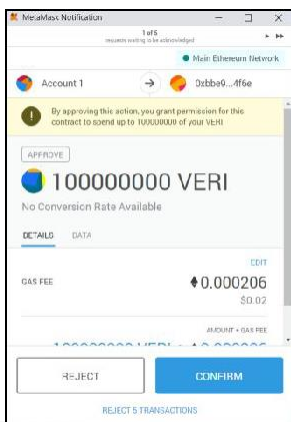
The “Enable tokens” menu will open. Click the slide button () behind each token you want to enable.



When you have selected all the tokens you want to enable, click update.



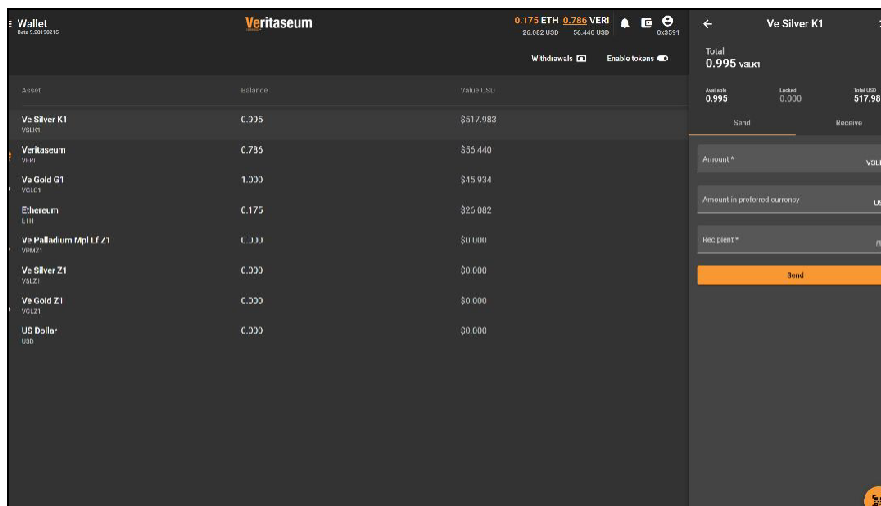
Enabling tokens will make Ethereum transactions, which you need to confirm through Metamask or your wallet. Please note that this will only cost the gas price (transaction fee).



You will see that 100,000,000 VERI will be enabled, which should cover all your future transactions and thus prevent you from having to enable tokens again. You can also click on Enable Tokens to disable tokens if you'd like. When you have clicked confirmed for each of your tokens, you must wait for them to be confirmed on the Blockchain. This may take a few minutes or more. Upon successful completion of all the transactions, a notification will be momentarily displayed. Your account is now set up and ready for use.

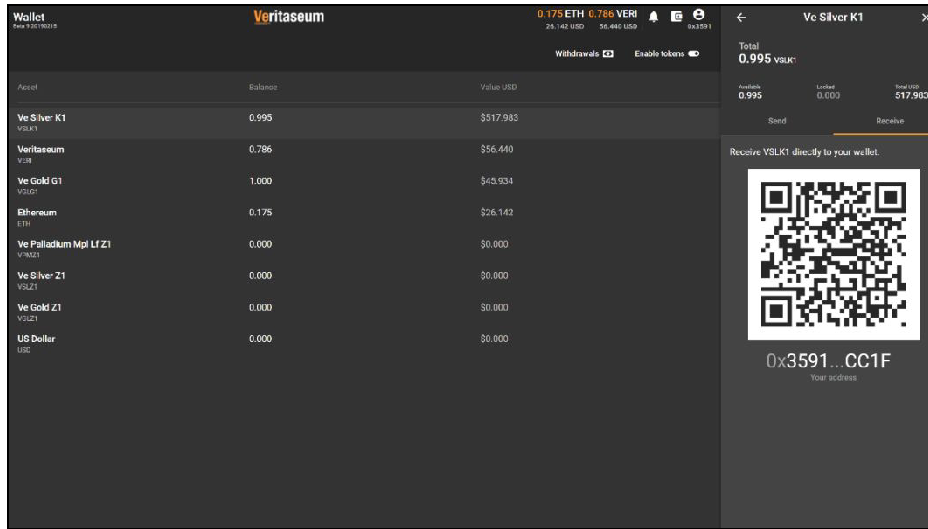
- **Sending and Receiving VeAssets and Tokens through VeWallet**

You can easily send and receive tokens using the VeWallet interface. First, select the asset you want to send or receive. This will open the send/receive box.

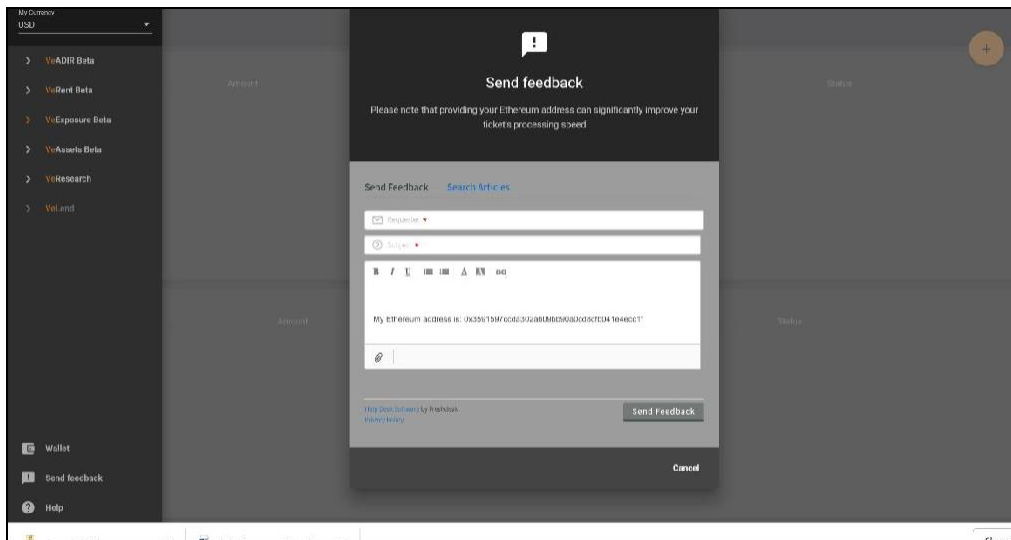


To send, enter the amount of the asset you wish to send. It will also show the corresponding value in the currency of your choice. Input the recipient address and click send.


To receive, you can scan the wallet QR code and enter the amount to be received.



- Below the wallet is the **Send Feedback** and **Customer Support** buttons. Use these to report any issues you are having with the function of the VeADIR or to share ideas or helpful improvements.



Simply fill out your information, including email address and your name. Enter a description of your issue or question. Note that your Ethereum address is automatically included, to assist the support team and significantly improve your ticket's resolution speed. Attach any supporting documentation. You can also Search Articles to see if your question has been answered before. Then click **Send Feedback** to send your information to Veritaseum support.

- The last item on the menu is the Help button.  This will take you to this user guide and helpful videos.
- In the upper right hand corner of all pages, you will see the amount of ETH and VERI currently in your wallet along with a corresponding currency equivalent value underneath these amounts. There is also a notification bell that will have a red icon if you have any notifications related to your account. Simply click the bell to view the notifications. You will also see a person icon with your wallet address to indicate that you are logged in with the appropriate wallet.
